Girls' Math Club

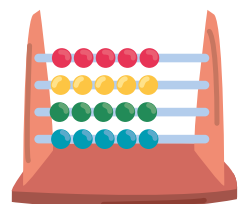
Empower girls to gain self-esteem, interpersonal skills, and confidence in mathematics with Calculus Roundtable's "Girls' Math Club!"

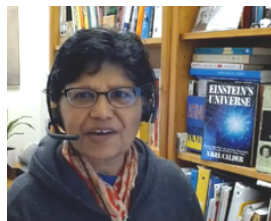

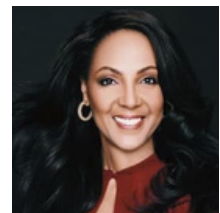
